History

The concept of the Western States Hockey League was established at a meeting in Southern California in early 1994. In attendance were several interested parties with the common goal of developing a Junior League located in the Western United States. Originally, the League was established to give the 15-20 year old players in the Western US an opportunity to participate in a high level hockey league without having to travel to the Midwest or East. It was decided that the organization should be governed by the concepts of the United States Amateur Hockey Association (USA Hockey).

The WSHL incorporated in Southern California in June 1994 and made application to USA Hockey as a Junior B League. Granting of "Interim status" was received and the inaugural season schedule of 30 games began in October 1994. The original 6 teams. Today, the WSHL is a 14 team league with teams in Lakewood, CA, Valencia CA, San Diego CA, Boulder CO, Dallas TX, San Antonio TX, Tulsa OK, El Paso TX, Albuquerque NM, Bakersfield CA, Peoria AZ, Fresno CA and Boise ID, Phoenix AZ.

Under the new format of Tier III—Jr. A, maximum tuition is \$6500 which covers all on ice, off ice training, games, travel, all team outer wear, helmets, stick allowance, etc. When compared to Midget Tier I costs, it represents about a 50% savings over playing Midget Tier I. All games are broadcast on the internet.

The BOMBERS, were one of the founding teams in the WSHL and have participated in every season since 1995-1996 first season. The BOMBERS, have many alumni who have participated in both the USHL, NAHL, as well as Division I, III NCAA College Hockey and minor professional leagues. The Bombers have participated in playoffs of the WSHL 12 of the 14 years they have been in the league.

The So Cal Bombers Junior 'A' Hockey Club will be hosting their annual Prospect Camp May 14th-16th at Glacial Garden Skating Arena – Lakewood CA. This is your chance to become a part of the successful track record the Bombers have built over the last 14 years.

The 3 day camp will have up to 4 on ice sessions run by Head Coach J.F. Picard and staff. Also as part of the try-out camp, personal athletic testing, team jersey, group lunch on Sat. and individual player interviews with the coaching staff and team management. All players must pre-register by May 1 to ensure a spot at camp. And all camp attendees will need to register with USA Hockey for the 2010-2011 season.
